[Section 18; G.N. No. 274 of 1974]

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (National Game) Order, and shall come into operation on the date of the commencement of the Wildlife Conservation Act¹.
- 2. The animals specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby declared to be national game to which section 19 of the Wildlife Conservation Act shall apply.
