Judiciary Administration (Judiciary Flag)

(c) have a judiciary emblem at the centre.

(3) The Judiciary emblem shall be a round image of lady justice holding a book and a scale encircled by the colours of the National Flag with the phrases “the Judiciary of Tanzania” and “Mahakama ya Tanzania” around it.

Flying flags on court houses

4. The Judiciary flag shall be hoisted at all court houses on the left side based the National flag while facing the flags from the court house.

Flag in office

5. The Chief Justice and Jaji Kiongozi shall hoist the flag-

(a) in their respective offices on the left side when working; and

(b) at their official residences.

Miniature flags on tables

6. The Justices of Appeal, Judges of the High Court, Chief Registrar, Chief Court Administrator, Registrar of the Court of Appeal and Registrar of the High Court may hoist miniature flags on the left side of their desks when working.

Miniature flags on cars

7.-(1) The Chief Justice shall fly the miniature national flag on the left side of his car in accordance with the Standing Orders of the Public Service, 2009.

(2) The Jaji Kiongozi shall fly the Judiciary miniature flag on the left side of his official motor vehicle.

(3) Every Judge in-charge shall fly a miniature flag on the left of his official vehicle within his jurisdiction except where the Chief Justice or the Jaji Kiongozi is present, as the case may be.

Time of flying Judiciary flag

8. The Judiciary flag shall be hoisted or flown from 6:00 a.m to 6:00 p.m.

Worn out flag not to be used

9. The Chief Court of Administrator shall ensure that no worn out, torn or dirty flag is hoisted or flown.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Made under regulation 2)

1. The Judiciary flag:

(a) the design of the Judiciary flag is as hereunder.



(b) the Judiciary flag's width to length ratio shall be 2:3 and the size shall be as shown below:

- (i) the Judiciary flag to fly on flagpoles shall be 1220mm hoist (width) and 1830 fly (length) of flag.
- (ii) the Judiciary miniature flags on tables shall be 102mm hoist and 155mm fly.
- (iii) the Judiciary miniature flags on cars be 152mm hoist and 228mm fly.
- (iv) the Judiciary large flag to fly on large buildings and on the headquarters of the building shall be 1830mm hoist and 2745 mm hoist.

- (c) the material of the Judiciary outdoor and indoor flags shall be polyester cotton bunting respectively.
- (d) the Judiciary flag shall consist of equal size round stripes of the colours of the National Flag with green on outmost circle.
- (e) the diameter of the outmost circle shall be two third of the respective hoist (width) of the flag.
